

PACP™ Version 8 is Here!



While certification in PACP Version 7 remains valid until your certification period ends, you may choose to upgrade your current PACP Version 7 certification to Version 8. **Here's how:** □

If you were certified 6/1/2023 or AFTER:

You have been automatically enrolled in a free Upgrade Course. You can find the Course under “My Courses” on your home screen. Login to your NASSCO Training Source account now to take it!

Note that the Free Upgrade Course includes a Version 8 manual in digital format only, but a hard copy manual is available for purchase for \$85 in the Course Catalogs on the right side of your home screen.

Once you successfully complete the course, you will receive a new certificate that indicates you have reviewed the version 8 materials, but please note that your original certification expiration date will remain the same.

If you were certified BEFORE 6/1/2023:

You may purchase an online Upgrade Course and Version 8 manual (digital and hard copy) for \$175. Login now to purchase the course! You can find it in the Course Catalogs on the right side of your home screen.

Once you successfully complete the course, you will receive a new certificate that indicates you have reviewed the version 8 materials, but please note that your original certification expiration date will remain the same.

Recertification options at launch

Due to recertify? Students requiring recertification must take a trainer-led course, either virtually or in person. Note that NASSCO is working on an online, self-paced recertification course for Version 8, but it will not be available until late 2024.

Why switch to Version 8?

What NASSCO's PACP|LACP|MACP Version 8 will do for you and the industry:

- Clarify coding definitions and examples.
- Address coding of defects in new pipe vs. existing pipe.
- Update condition grades.
- Introduce new code sets including Pressure Pipe, Stormwater and Perforated Pipes.
- Provide guidance on how to ensure quality inspection deliverables.
- Show how PACP|LACP|MACP data can be utilized for wise asset management decisions.

What about earlier versions?

With the release of PACP Version 8, NASSCO will only be training on the Version 8 manual and codes. Certification in PACP Version 7 remains valid, however, until certification periods end. In addition, NASSCO will be sunsetting Versions 6 and earlier which means those versions will no longer be included as part of the software certification process, and software vendors may no longer support those older software versions.
