


If you detect an odor in your home, it is likely entering through the pipe that connects your home to the public sewer main. To minimize the odor, pour ½ gallon of water in all plumbing fixtures and drains to fill your P-traps, preferably prior to the start of the project. If you smell the odor in your home, ventilate the area by opening windows and doors.

Adding more water to the P-traps and using a fan may help eliminate the smell faster.
